Subject: Establishment of new medical college in the name and style of "S.S. Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre" at Davangere -Permission of Central Govt. - regarding.

Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's letter of intent of even number dated 10th June and with reference to your letter No. BEA/16/Adm/2006-07 dated 10.6.06, I am directed to convey the approval of the Central Government to the establishment of a new medical college in the name and style of "S.S. Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre" at Davangere by Bapuji Educational Association with an annual intake of 150(one hundred fifty) students with prospective effect i.e. from the academic session 2006-07 under Section 10(A) of IMC Act, 1956 as amended.

2. This permission of the Central Govt. for establishment of the college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievement of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India. The college shall not admit more than one batch of students against this letter of permission. The college shall also apply to Medical council of India for renewal of permission well before the commencement of next academic session. While applying for such renewal, the achievement in terms of infrastructure, staff and equipment as spelt out in the time bound action plan and as required by Medical Council of India norms must be clearly indicated. The next batch of students shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Central Government.

3. The permission is subject to the Bank guarantee of Rs. 9.50 crores (Rs 2.00 crores towards medical college and 7.50 crores towards hospital facilities) furnished by Bapui Educational Trust, Davangere for establishment of medical college and hospital found to be adequate/genuine on all counts. The admission process for the academic year 2006-07 has to be completed in accordance with the time schedule indicated in the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997, as amended.


