1.	24yr old Male	A case of yellow phosphorous (RATTOL/RAT poison) compound poisoning with acute liver injury came with GCS E4V5M6, RR-16cpm, Spo2 - 98% @ RA,BP-132/80 mmHg,HR-98bpm, Pupils- B/L- 3mm RTL. Patient had deranged LFTs and high lactate levels, was admitted and treated with IV antibiotics, IV hepatoprotective agents and other supportive medications. 2 sessions of plasmapheresis was done following which liver parameters improved and came to normal limits and patient was discharged.
2.	28year old Male	A case of aluminium phosphide poisoning came with GCS E4V5M6, RR-16cpm, Spo2 - 98% @ RA,BP-128/72 mmHg, HR-88bpm, Pupils- B/L- 3mm RTL. Patient was managed in male emergency ward. Forensic analysis was sent which showed presence of phosphorous compound. Early aggressive management and plasmapheresis prevented acute liver injury due to phosphorous compound and was discharged.


